SYRAH CASABLANCA VALLEY VINTAGE: 2017

The wine is easier than the name. Very pure, focused blackberries pervade the nose and palate. There's a sleek, lively feel to the tannins here. They hold long and fresh, carrying plenty of sweet ripe-fruit flavor. Drink or hold.



CABERNET SAUVIGNON MAIPO VALLEY VINTAGE: 2017

A firm, focused young red with currant and blackberry character. Some bitter chocolate. Medium-bodied, fresh and taut. Drinkable now, but better after 2021.



VIGNO - CARIGNAN MAULE VALLEY VINTAGE: 2017

Alluring nose, full of black and blue fruit, heather and peppermint. Fresh with high-tone acidity and juicy fruit. Dense, firm and long with a eucalyptus note in the finish. Really delicious to drink now.



CHARDONNAY LIMARI VALLEY VINTAGE: 2018

Chalky-lemon, green-mango and pineapple character. Medium-bodied with a mineral streak on the palate. Vibrant acidity cleanses



SAUVIGNON BLANC ELQUI VALLEY VINTAGE: 2018

Aromas of slightly grilled asparagus, pure gooseberries and passion fruit. Tart, green guava on the very sappy, bright palate and a dry, chalky finish. Drink now. Screw cap.



BRUT - PINOT NOIR CURICO VALLEY VINTAGE: NO

Hints of brioche, pears and lemon curd. Creamy bubles with restrained, biscuit flavors on the palate. Drink



CARMENÈRE CACHAPOAL VALLEY D.O. PEUMO

VINTAGE: 2017

This has a sheen of toasty oak, amid an array of fresh flowers and bright red berries. Fruit takes the lead on the palate with a smooth, fine-tannin texture.

Drink now.



BRUT ROSÉ - PAÍS MAULE VALLEY VINTAGE: NO

Delightful sparkling rosé, made from pais, offering pretty red berries, nectarines and flower petals. Light, simple and crisp on the palate. Goes well with light dishes. Drink now.
